

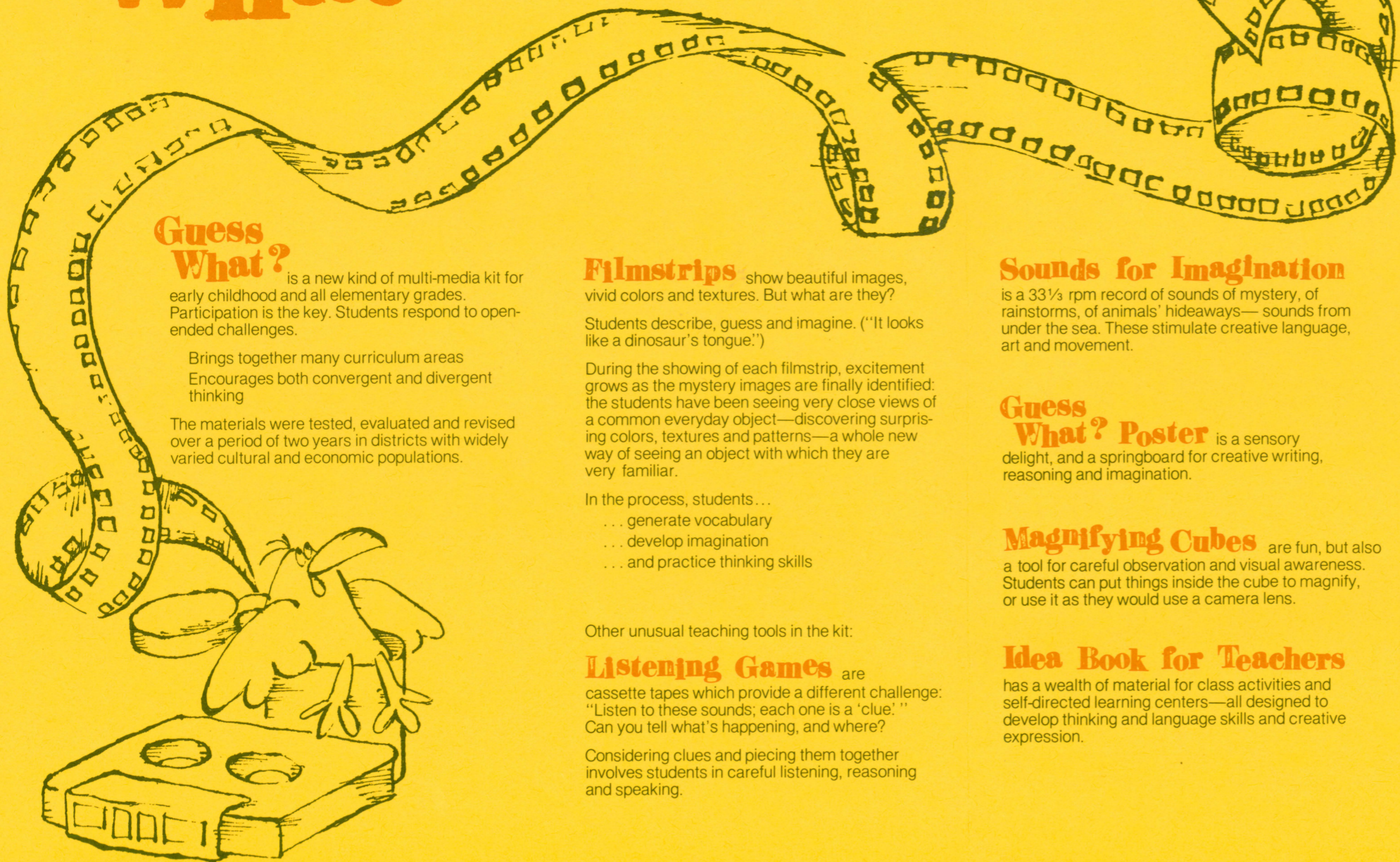

Guess What?

is a new kind of multi-media kit for early childhood and all elementary grades. Participation is the key. Students respond to open-ended challenges.

Brings together many curriculum areas
Encourages both convergent and divergent thinking

The materials were tested, evaluated and revised over a period of two years in districts with widely varied cultural and economic populations.

Filmstrips show beautiful images, vivid colors and textures. But what are they?

Students describe, guess and imagine. ("It looks like a dinosaur's tongue.")

During the showing of each filmstrip, excitement grows as the mystery images are finally identified: the students have been seeing very close views of a common everyday object—discovering surprising colors, textures and patterns—a whole new way of seeing an object with which they are very familiar.

In the process, students ...
... generate vocabulary
... develop imagination
... and practice thinking skills

Other unusual teaching tools in the kit:

Listening Games are cassette tapes which provide a different challenge: "Listen to these sounds; each one is a 'clue.' " Can you tell what's happening, and where?

Considering clues and piecing them together involves students in careful listening, reasoning and speaking.

Sounds for Imagination

is a 33 $\frac{1}{3}$ rpm record of sounds of mystery, of rainstorms, of animals' hideaways— sounds from under the sea. These stimulate creative language, art and movement.

Guess What? Poster

is a sensory delight, and a springboard for creative writing, reasoning and imagination.

Magnifying Cubes

are fun, but also a tool for careful observation and visual awareness. Students can put things inside the cube to magnify, or use it as they would use a camera lens.

Idea Book for Teachers

has a wealth of material for class activities and self-directed learning centers—all designed to develop thinking and language skills and creative expression.
