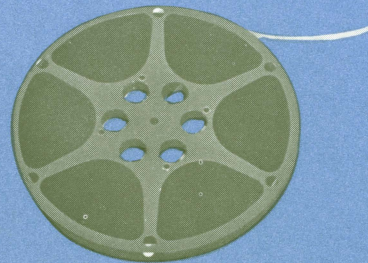
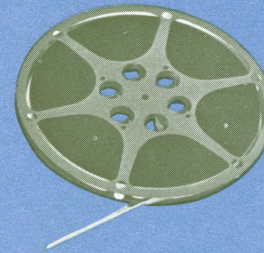
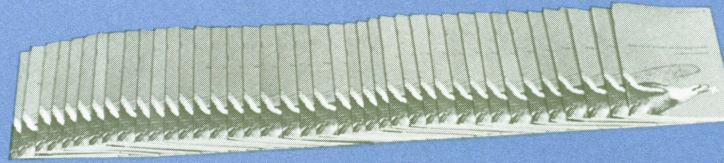
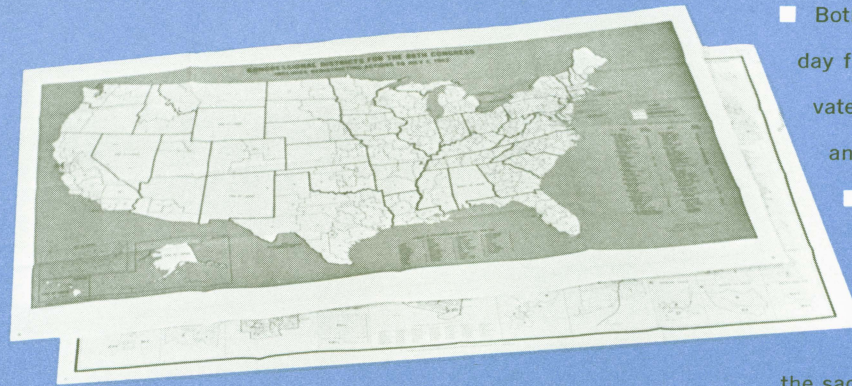
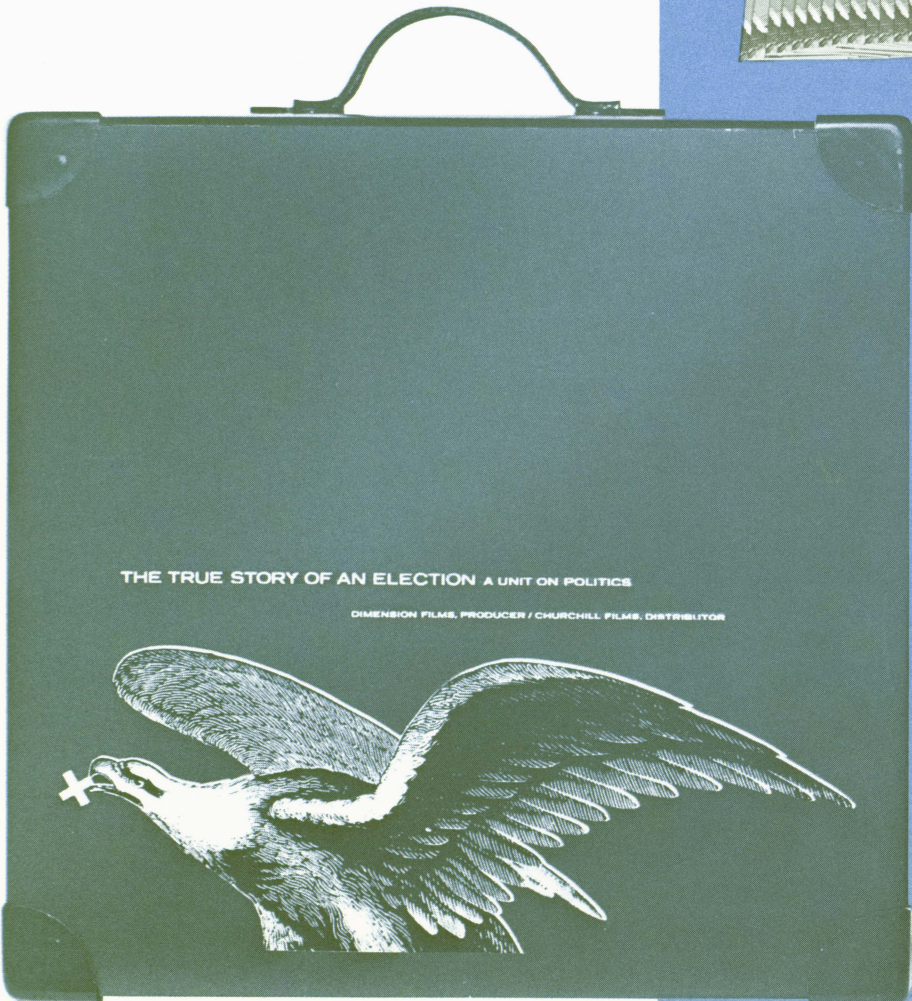
THE TRUE STORY OF AN ELECTION

■ The unit presents the elements of a typical political campaign — the people, the problems, the financing, the strategy, the procedure, the hard work, the tension and excitement, and the sacrifices and rewards.

■ It shows that high school and college students can play vital, responsible roles in politics.

the unit includes:

FILM The film is in two parts, 30 and 26 minutes. In Part 2, before the result is revealed, there is a space to stop the projector and conduct a discussion.

HANDBOOKS There is a set of 40 Student Handbooks providing additional documents and research from the campaign. There is one Teacher's Handbook containing detailed suggestions for ways to use the unit.

MAPS There are 2 wall maps showing the Congressional Districts of the United States.

KIT The Unit is packaged in a permanent fibreboard kit. (Colored red, white, and blue, of course.)
